Community Impact

VIOLENCE PREVENTION

- ◆ 93% of callers to a crisis line for domestic violence were given support, information, safety planning options, and connected with community resources to deal with the violence in their life.
- ◆ 86% of children exposed to domestic violence who are staying in a shelter, demonstrated a positive change in behavior as they learned alternatives to violence through a prevention program for children.

ENSURING ADULT SELF SUFFICIENCY

- ◆ 93% of people with a disability who signed up for workshops through an independent living center, gained knowledge about healthy living habits, self-advocacy skills, ADA rights, benefits available, history of disability services, and the culture of living with a disability in our nation.
- ◆ 100% of youth in juvenile detention who earned the opportunity to attend literacy and life skills classes, were given information through a literacy center about effective problem solving and ways to improve their situation.
- ◆ 100% of adults with a developmental disability in an advocacy program who needed help managing money, paid their living expenses on time and made regular payments on medical bills and other debts. 85% have no debts and have money saved for at least one month's essential living expenses.
- ◆ 100% of learners requiring one-on-one tutoring improved their ability to read, write, and comprehend English with 75% receiving their GED through help from a literacy program.

HELPING YOUTH SUCCEED

- ◆ 85% of children mentored by a caring adult volunteer, reported an increased ability to trust others. 75% looked forward to a bright future according to reports by parents/teachers.
- ◆ 100% of youth in scouting were active in academic, sports or advancement programs to learn leadership, develop recreational and career interests, and build life skills.
- ◆ 90% of youth in an after-school program attended classes like music, art, cooking, and crafts to develop hobbies, explore talents, build confidence, and learn new skills.
- ◆ 99% of children in foster care who were given a voice in the court system through an advocacy program, remained with the same advocate.
- ◆ 100% of girls in scouting gained leadership skills through self discovery, connecting with others, and taking action by helping others.

CRISIS INTERVENTION

- ◆ 100% of callers to a mental health crisis line received support, information, referrals, and assessment.
- ◆ 84% of homeless families and individuals seeking sleeping bags and tents were assisted.

IMPROVING HEALTH & WELLNESS

- ◆ 100% of youth residing in a shelter for youth in crisis saw a health care provider.
- ◆ 94% of girls living in a mental health therapeutic group home abstained from drug and alcohol use.
- ◆ 97% of children attending a preschool for low income families received regular dental care. 96% were current on their immunizations and wellness check-ups.
- ◆ 100% of 65 local day cares received partial reimbursement from a food program so healthy meals can be served to 1,960 children
